
Could your pet benefit from Laser Therapy?



Laser therapy is a non-invasive treatment option that uses light energy to penetrate targeted tissue for reduced inflammation, decreased pain, and accelerated healing. This technology allows our trained staff to provide comfort to pets in a variety of situations while reducing the need for traditional oral medications. We highly recommend this therapy if your pet:

- Has had a recent surgical procedure
- ♦ Is experiencing joint or spinal pain
- Is suffering from inflammation due to infection (ear infections, healing wounds, skin infections, ect.)

This FDA approved treatment is provided in our office, takes just a few minutes, and does not require sedation or medications for your pet. In addition to being an affordable alternative to surgical treatment, you can often see results within hours of the first use and additional benefits with continued treatment.

What does Laser Therapy cost?

Laser therapy is incredibly versatile and can be used on most areas of pain and inflammation to speed recovery time and reduce discomfort. Treatment for some areas of the body, such as joints, require a higher intensity light treatment, while delicate areas or growths require less time for treatment. Below are examples of commonly treated conditions.

Level 1– Ear hematomas or infections

Level 2– Growths and post surgical treatment

Level 3— Joint pain such as hips, shoulder, elbows, and knees.

This therapy can be used to treat chronic conditions like arthritis or acute injury. Improvement can often be seen in just one session; however, for chronic conditions we recommended a series of treatments to ensure maximum relief for your pet!
